Viticulture & Vineyard

Our dry farmed bush vines are situated in the high-altitude village of Kripan nestled near the Sierra Cantabria Mountain range.

The vineyards are located on terraced ravines surrounded by forests and native flora. Due to old vines with narrow spacing between rows, we employ draft horses to gently work the limestone soils.

To cultivate and preserve a high level of biodiversity above and below the soil, our land is tended following Biodynamic farming practices with minimal tillage.

Harvest & Winemaking

During harvest the bunches are collected in small boxes to avoid premature crushing before they reach the cellar.

The Malvasia from our Barrera vineyard undergoes a slow and gentle press. All other vineyards are destemmed, fermentation starts spontaneously with the skins.

After pressing the blend is placed into a 1.800 L Foudre where it rests with its fine lees. Following six months, the wine is racked into 500 L French oak barrels where it ages another 18 months prior to bottling. No forced malolactic fermentation allows the process to happen naturally during the aging process.
